- Station remains closed to all volunteers, maintaining extensive amount of programming
- Audit has been submitted! Shout out to Zale and staff for deep digging!
- Facilties--we have a calendar to have social distancing amongst staff
- Covid 19 Budget- spent \$605.99 so far (remote access software support, mic covers, cleaning services, pending for zoom account, we aren't able to get a laptops because they are out of stock,
- Support to programmers has expanded a lot and programmers are being trained via zoom and other volunteers are teaching editing etc by Jenka and Arthur. Programmer meetings are WAY more accessible online
- Webpage has been updated regularly
- Trying to be a support to the community at large. Big ups to tech team and programming. Althea has been doing remote news production. Wow!
- We need help with audio editing!! It's falling on staff right now.
- Public affairs is streaming mayoral debate live
- Webinar coming up Friday....to utilize Zoom for accessing KBOO
- Revenue operations-Online appeals, got some grant \$ CPB 75,000 dollars, Juan Young 2500 youth programming, waiting to hear about Collins foundation, May 5th Giving Tuesday,

- Staffing- Development director Tom Lane moved to Maine and decided to find a job and make it stable. Big shoes to fill! : (May 3rd is his last day. Board feel free to contact him to do your training, We are having exit interviews and doing "brain dump." He will help with 10 hrs a week until June of volunteering to help with the hire.
- We have 5 vacancies in our staffing. More in depth in the station manager report. Technically 6 but Michael is temporary.
- Erin Yanke is also resigning as of May 1st

Emma- thank you, and wondering moving forward do we have funding for all those vacancies?

Celeste-we are reviewing with MacRae weekly and keeping an eye on what we can and cannot afford.

Executive Officer's Report Katmeow 7 min

 Management's proposal to the board, game plans and ideas to move forward if budget needs to shift and will be brought to the table soon, and discussed at next board meeting. Lots of hours being done as Station Manager that aren't reflected in the job description.

Emma-not feeling satisfied with the answer I received regarding Economic Depression. want the board to advocate for the long term health of the organization. We need to have more conversation. I support SM's \$. We need to look at this.

Celeste: Just because we have 6 positions, doesn't mean that we need to do it. What would it look like to not have a volunteer coordinator? We are thinking outside of the box. Most critical are Development, Program director and Data Coordinator. We are on board and will get you that information.

Engineering Report Update by Theresa and Arthur 5min

• We should have volunteers monitoring station, shifted all staff to remote work, non essential repairs halted, live remote is in the works, training hosts is a big hurdle, always extra funding would be great, or go to staff salaries

Finance update by Theresa

- Are we on track to meet goal? Yes but with Station Manager with no benefits,
- Liquidity
- Op Reserve
- Grants

- No Spring Pledge Drive 20,000 match on pledges-goal is 77,000
- Member support, receiving renewals and new members
- Eugene-letter to board-reviewing \$ and concerned that the board will need clear and accurate updates regarding finances. Financial projections are muddy and count the \$100 K donation as surplus and board already voted to divide this surplus into different categories. Also projects the \$ for other fundraising, as if unaffected by current financial situation. suggests Emergency Grants go into the Operating Reserves and allows board receive a monthly summary of \$ spent. Very concerned about pandemic and future for 2021 and beyond. Expect that KBOO should be audited and prepared for that.

Emma-thank you and look closely at Gene's letter.

Laurie-thank you

Shaheed- Thank you all, I wanted to say that I haven't heard about any of that, we need to have access to these numbers and I agree we need to think about these numbers Emma- we need to talk about 2 things- renewing the reserves, and prep for an audit Karla-we are going to get everything emailed to us? I haven't had an info before today and I would like to review it.

Laurie-Agenda has setting time for the May budget review and will be planning for this in a few minutes

- Sarah- I need more information if we are going to rescind a bonus.
- Jenna-wondering where that came from for transparency and clarity...
- Shaheed-nowhere are people talking about bonus' right now.
- Gene- recommendation from finance committee to board and recognition of what staff had gone through in the fall

- Karla-I would like to add, individuals promised a bonus, are being covered. Who are we not to do the same.
- Celeste-I would like to have time for Jenna and I to ask for what they want. We applied for paycheck protection, the money is drying up.
- Jenna- re-iterate what Celeste said. Reassuring that folks have a job
- Karla- I want more information. IRS code is changing. I think we should get more reporting.
- Emma- couple of things, concerned-we made this decision as a board in closed committee. I don't think that this decision will secure a job or not.
- Sarah-folks that are leaving, people can privately re-donate it to KBOO.
- Shaheed makes a motion to delay payment until Celeste can take a poll.

Karla second it. Shaheed : yes Karla- no Emma- No Theresa- no Marvin- No Ruba-No Laurie-No KatMeow- chair does not vote.

6 opposed 1 in favor Chair does not vote.

Emma makes friendly amendment: we love and respect Shaheed and Celeste and Jenna, this is just a vote by the board and does not mean to undermine them or their standpoints.
