4:30 Welcome

Discussion: What constitutes quorum? List of members who only occasionally show up? Bylaws only state that "member who attends 3 consecutive meetings" is a member of committee, so we assume that to resume membership a member has to attend 3 meetings to be "reinstated"

Bren thinks YouTube livestream best format

6-8 acts, 1/12-2 hours for the program

Introduce each act separately; host (Bren) introduces, asks questions, pitches for both artist and KBOO

Thinks appeals to eclectic KBOO audience (feature C/W, comics, hip hop, real variety); if each artist has 10 fans, multiplied by variety of artists and devoted KBOO listeners

What is best nite of the week? Bren says depends on structure: if variety showcase could build it that way; or, could select a program that already has a big listenership, could reward the program by livestreaming

Jessica: question of coordinating w/livestreaming on regular programming (different from the BAM! Event that was only on zoom not radio) Jill: Celeste had suggested partnering w/existing jazz fest Bren: PDX hip hop week (going on since '90s, every August), still not a lot of people know about it; a festival that goes to different venues Options for KBOO: could get sanctioned by Hip Hop Week to be the brand Jessica: could be the kick-off credit, a show at beginning of week

Laurie: costs, approval process?

Bren: anyone can pay \$50 to be co-sponsor; KBOO would be a part so could be official press; we could create OUR flier w/KBOO name, "hip hop show powered by KBOO" or "cosponsored with KBOO"

Committee enthusiastic about idea; kudos to Bren for initiating

Next steps:

- Bren will make connections w/PDX Hip Hop Wk and find out next steps for approval, etc (for cosponsorship, costs, etc); Bren volunteered to pay the cosponsorship costs, will be minimal
- Need to consult w/station comanagers (Bren confident Celeste will approve, have been discussing for few years); Jill will talk to managers about 1) whether we can cosponsor, 2) whether can use KBOO logo
- Location: Bren has vet's status and can get venues for cheap; e.g., Amer Legion hall on Alberta, can get for very minimal cost
- Jill: Devmt Comm can help to promote
- camera/tech crew: Bren could hire crew he uses, or rely on KBOO
- Costs: Bren estimates about \$800 in costs
- Ticket sales: if covid venue cap, minimum 50 @ \$10, plus donations pitching, livestream event tickets
- During event, someone should be responsible for posting on social media
- Have someone (perhaps Bren as host) walk across stage with info on donating to KBOO, Venmo #
- Artists will be compensated by videotape, exposure on KBOO, lots of people watching; will help their careers a lot; "they're using us a lot more than we are using them"; very easy for Bren to get artists to participate
